Palais des Festivals et des Congrès de Cannes awarded GBAC STAR™ Facility accreditation, the international benchmark in health security

The Palais des Festivals et des Congrès of Cannes received the international certification GBAC STAR. This certification by an independent body attests to the good implementation of sanitary measures in the face of the Covid-19 risk, reinforcing the protocols in terms of cleaning, disinfection and prevention of infectious diseases

Guided by the French Government, the World Health Organization (WHO) health measures and the RX COVID Management Plan, our actions are subject to change overtime in accordance with associated recommendations.



1. Sanitary pass

Per application of current French sanitary regulations, participants* must provide a valid sanitary pass** to access the show.

The sanitary pass requires the participant to provide either proof of vaccination, a negative RT-PCR or antigen test (max 48 hours), or proof of immunity following infection (15 days < > 6 months). It can be provided in digital or paper format via a QR code. The European Medicines Agency has so far granted approvals to the following vaccines: BioNTech and Pfizer, Moderna, AstraZeneca and Janssen Pharmaceutica SA.

For all participants, notwithstanding our admission policy, we recommend downloading the «TousAntiCovid» application, to be vaccinated or have a negative test (max 48hr).

Spaces will be reorganised to enable face-to-face meetings while following social distancing measures.



9. On-site food services

Tables will be arranged to follow social distancing measures, with 1 m between each table and no more than 10 people per table.

10. Management of individuals with COVID symptoms

A medical team will be present for the duration of the event. Suspected COVID-19 cases will be isolated and handled by suitable health professionals.
